BDAE Group launches tariff

A new concept developed in co-operation with the risk carrier Wurzbürger Versicherungs-AG, Expat Visit offers its customers a greater scope of benefits than standard travel insurance products, such as not having a maximum time limit placed on a visit. The insurance policy also provides cover to Germans going abroad for up to a year, provided the visit is not for business purposes. Premiums are calculated on a per-day basis and linked to the exact length of the journey, without any additional costs. Among other benefits, the cover includes in- and out-patient treatment, pharmaceuticals, drugs and dressings, and medically necessary outpatient dental treatment.
